Accounting II - A two semester course. Recommended for grades 11-12 and Completion of Accounting IA and IB I with a grade of C or better.



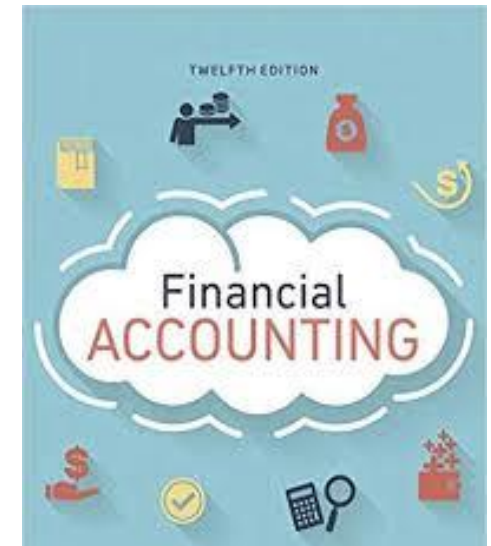
