# Adult Education Program Offerings

## Adult Basic Education Classes (ABE)

\*Designed for students assessed at the Low Intermediate Basic Level in reading and/or math level.

## Pre-GED Classes

\*Designed for students Assessed at the High Intermediate Basic Level in reading and/or Math.

## GED Classes

\*Designed for students assessed at the Adult Secondary Level. The GED is equivalent to a high school diploma, and the GED exam is administered by the State Department of Education in the following areas: Social Studies, Science, Reading, Writing and Math. GED classes assist students in preparing for these areas.

## Career Readiness

\*Designed for students wishing to obtain a Career Readiness/WorkKeys certificate. The Career Readiness Certificate/WorkKeys Program is an assessment system for developing, documenting and measuring "real world" skills critical to job success.

## High School Diploma Classes

\*Designed for students seeking to obtain a South Carolina high school diploma. Students must have a minimum of 12 units to enter the program, and they must meet requirements set by the SC Department of Education.

\*Diploma fees are \$50.00 per unit & \$25.00 for half units. Fees are due prior to starting class, payable by Cash or Money Order.

## English as a Second Language (ESL)

\*Designed to assist students needing help communicating in the English Language.

## Transition Program

\*Designed to assist adult education students with the college application process, individual career plans, employability skills and job search referrals.

## GED and High School Diploma Information

### Eligibility Requirements

- 18 years of age or older (17 year olds who have been released from their high school may be admitted with a signed release from the school district of residence)
- Currently work or reside in Spartanburg County

### Enrollment Policy

Individuals may enter classes any time after completing an intake and orientation process. See individual center information in this brochure for new student intake days and times.

Students 21 and under who received special education services while enrolled in school must have an IEP meeting upon enrollment and prior to beginning classes to determine if adult education is an appropriate educational placement. Contact the local adult education program for more information.

- Nonrefundable Registration fee \$25.00 (Cash or Money Order only)
- Driver's License or State ID
- Social Security Card (or copy)
- Release from high school of residence (17 year olds only)
